## NMFS Announces Final Atlantic Bluefin Tuna Quotas and Effort Controls for the 2008 Fishing Year

The National Marine Fisheries Service (NMFS) announces the final rule to set the 2008 fishing year quotas for the Atlantic bluefin tuna (BFT) fishery and effort controls. The current U.S. Atlantic bluefin tuna (BFT) baseline quota of 1,165.12 mt, recommended at the 2006 meeting of the International Commission for the Conservation of Atlantic Tunas (ICCAT) and implemented in the final rule that set 2007 quota specifications and effort controls remains in effect until changed. In accordance with the Consolidated Atlantic Highly Migratory Species Fishery Management Plan (Consolidated HMS FMP), this final rule makes underharvest adjustments, as necessary, for the 2008 fishing year (January 1-December 31, 2008).

Complete 2007 fishing year landings information will be available in early 2008. However, based on current information, NMFS anticipates that the 2007 fishing year underharvest will be substantial. The current ICCAT recommendation limits the amount of underharvest that may be carried forward to 595.1 mt. In this action, NMFS carries over and distributes 595.1 mt of BFT underharvest from the 2007 fishing year to the 2008 fishing year quota, as shown in the attached table. Once complete information, including recreational landings estimates, is available for the 2007 fishing year, NMFS may need to publish quota adjustments or other management measures, as necessary, in 2008 for the 2008 fishing year.

The 2008 fishing year General category retention limits and Angling category retention limits are as follows:

<sup>\*</sup> Additional actions (adjustments) may be taken for subsequent time periods, as necessary.

NMFS is <u>not</u> implementing restricted fishing days (RFDs) through this final rule.

NMFS reminds permit holders that vessel permits issued for the 2007 fishing year are effective through December 31, 2008. There will be an opportunity to change permit category for the 2008 fishing year once during the period of January 1, 2008, through May 31, 2008.
